Presentation Title: “From Seed to Final Product: Development of Hemp
Fibre Industry in Alberta, Canada”

Jan J. Slaski is a Senior Researcher and a leader of Crop Development and Management team with the Ecosystems and Plant Sciences Unit of InnoTech Alberta, Vegreville, Alberta. He obtained a M.Sc. in agronomy from the Warsaw Agricultural University and Ph.D. from the Plant Breeding and Acclimatization Institute, Poland. During the last 16 years he has been leading research aimed at introduction and breeding of hemp varieties that suit the needs of the fibre and food industries on the Prairies. Jan has been also conducting extensive studies focused on the development of best management practices permitting sustainable hemp production under changing environmental conditions. To fully realize potential residing within this crop hemp and to assure whole crop utilization Jan assembled at InnoTech Alberta a program offering solutions from “seed to final product” that includes three domains: breeding and agronomy, fibre processing and product development. Since 2012, Jan has been serving hemp industry as a director of the Canadian Hemp Trade Alliance.
