## **2019 BUILDING INDUSTRY Scholarship:**

The Builders Group of Minnesota (TBG) is pleased to announce they are awarding \$2,000 in scholarships to students going into the building industry.

**Completed scholarship applications are due to the MMBA office by Monday • April 15, 2019 @ 3:00 pm.**

### **Eligibility:**

- Open to a graduating high school student **OR** recent high school graduate going into the building industry.
- They can be going into the trades or to a college to major in project or construction management.

### **The scholarship winners are determined by the following criteria:**

- Above average scholastic achievement is not a factor in receiving the scholarship.
- The scholarships are granted on the combined basis of need and merit.
- The applicant must be planning on continuing his/her education at any accredited post-secondary or technical institution of his/her choice.

### **Further guidelines are as follows:**

- The recipients will be given the scholarship in the form of a check made out to both the student and the school in which the student is enrolled. Half of the scholarship amount will be awarded at the MMBA General Membership Meeting on May 21, 2019. The other half will be awarded upon the MMBA receiving a copy of registration to the school of student's choice for their second semester.
- Scholarship winners will be notified by May 1, 2019.

### **Applications are due to the MMBA office by: Monday ~ April 15, 2019 at 3:00 pm.**

- Failure to submit a complete application on time will disqualify the applicant.
- Because the application pool varies each year, the scholarship committee will decide on the applicant's eligibility and/or number of scholarships awarded that year.
