Wednesday July 24, 2019 - Depart Calgary – Travel to Castlegar BC

- a. Hotel - Super 8 Castlegar – Tel – 1-250-365-2700 (Rebecca), Group Name – Concrete Alberta Road Trip
- b. Room cost \$121.50 (Includes Breakfast)
- c. **CUTOFF DATE: JUNE 24TH**. After that any rooms remaining will be released.
- d. Denis Mildenberger has graciously offered to host a BBQ Wednesday night.

Thursday July 25th and/or Friday July 26th, 2019 – Travel to Kelowna and then onto Vernon (Several routes possible).

- b. Room Cost - \$144.00 (Includes breakfast buffet)
- c. **CUTOFF DATE: MAY 31ST**. After that any remaining rooms will be released.
