



# Certified Installation Manager (CIM) Program Continuing Education Credits

To maintain your CIM certification, you must obtain at least thirty (30) new hours of approved professional development related to the flooring industry or project management.

## **What types of continuing education credits are available?**

Credits may be obtained from FCICA or other industry sources, such as:

- Educational sessions at FCICA Convention and Mid-Year meetings
- Educational sessions at other flooring industry conventions and meetings
- FCICA monthly educational webinars- **FREE to FCICA members**
- Other flooring industry educational webinars
- Construction industry educational webinars

- Manufacturer or distributor product webinars
- Manufacturer trainings
- Company trainings or seminars
- Project management seminars or courses

## **CEU submission**
