

Connecticut Recyclers Coalition Proposed Changes to the Bylaws

September 14, 2018

At the July 18, 2018 Connecticut Recyclers Coalition's Board of Directors meeting, members approved recommended changes to the organization's bylaws. The Directors believe that the proposed changes provide needed clarification and will improve the Board's ability to act on behalf of the membership. A brief explanation of each change is outlined below.

Article V. Board of Directors, Section 1. Number.

Remove the last line about board composition and create a new section devoted exclusively to board composition.

Article V. Board of Directors, Section 3. Board Composition.

Add a new section on board composition which specifies board representation.

Article V. Board of Directors, Section 4. Election of Directors.

Add sentences about who counts the ballots and how a tie vote is handled.

Article V. Board of Directors, Section 6. Proxy.

Add a new section allowing board members to designate an alternate.

Article VI. Meetings of the Board of Directors, Section 6. Board Action Without Meeting.

Replace current wording with new to allow electronic voting by the Board.

Article IX. Administration. Section 2. Annual Budget.

Add a new section requiring the Board of Directors to adopt an annual budget.
