



2018 ACE AWARDS ENTRY RULES AND REQUIREMENTS – ONLINE SUBMISSION

The **ACE Awards** program is open to all general contractor and specialty contractor member firms in good standing with AGC Colorado for projects within the Rocky Mountain Region (contiguous states including: CO, NM, AZ, UT, WY). For joint ventures all members of the joint venture, or the joint venture itself, or the managing partner and at least 50% of the joint venture partnership, must be a member(s) of AGC Colorado.

Projects completed or substantially completed between September 2017 to September 2018 are eligible for the 2018 awards program. A firm may enter more than one entry in a category; however, the same project may not be submitted in more than one category. Each entry will need its own completed online entry.

There is a limit of 3 submissions per company.

AGC reserves the right to adjust categories based on number of submissions received.

All entries shall be submitted online at www.AGCACE.com no later than Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at 5:00pm MDT.

Each online entry must include:

- A written narrative to be submitted in a PDF - maximum file size 10MB. The word limit is 1500 words, Times New Roman 12 point font, line spacing 1.5 and 1" top, bottom, and side margins. There is a 10 page limit. **The PDF will include the 1500 word narrative along with up to 10 photos embedded at the end of the PDF to tell the story of the project.** NOTE: The criteria for the narrative is in the "Categories of Submission and Requirements" document.
- Online payment of \$295 entry fee per submission.
- Once you submit your entry online, you will then submit your PDF narrative separate high resolution photos through WeTransfer.com. (See Submission Requirements document.)

Judging of entries will be by a panel of out-of-state judges from the public and private sector allied with the construction industry. All entries will be judged for excellence in construction techniques.

Entries not in compliance with these rules, as determined by the ACE Awards Committee, may not be considered. All decisions of the committee and judges are final.
