

MPA Engine Fuel Incentive Program

Engine Fuel Incentive Program Rules and Regulations

WHO AND WHAT IS ELIGIBLE? Incentives are available to Minnesota residents, companies, farms, fleets & industry members who purchase a new propane vehicle or convert an existing gasoline powered vehicle with an EPA certified propane system or install a new propane powered engine for irrigation purposes.

WHAT VEHICLES ARE ELIGIBLE? Any vehicle 2009 or newer, 16,000 GVW or less that is registered and operated in the state of Minnesota is eligible. School buses must be new bus propane purchases.

WHEN DOES THE PROGRAM BEGIN AND END? The program began March 19, 2018 and ends when program funds are exhausted. The purchase and installation of the system must occur after March 19, 2018, and the request must be submitted within 60 days of purchase or installation. The payment of an incentive under the program of this agreement is subject to available funds. All eligible purchases or conversion installations must occur during the incentive program period.

INCENTIVE AMOUNTS

Autogas Vehicle Purchase or Conversion of Existing Gasoline Models with EPA certified equipment 2009 or Newer \$4,000, limit 3 per applicant.

Installation of a NEW 2016 or newer Propane Powered Irrigation engine—\$300 per liter engine size.

Purchase of NEW propane powered school bus (s), limit 4, \$2500 each

Installation of a NEW, public, self-service autogas refueling system. Up to \$20,000

Helping industry members apply for Alternate Fuel Grants, up to \$1000

VERIFICATION: Applicants must submit a paid receipt or paid invoice for the purchase of a new propane powered vehicle, EPA certified conversion of gasoline powered vehicle to propane or the installation of an Irrigation Engine.

Completed and approved applications should have an incentive check issued within 60-90 days after the application is received at the MPA office, subject to available funds. No applicant has a legal right or other entitlement to receive an incentive under the program or this agreement. A completed application does not bind MPA to approve or pay an incentive to any applicant.

Applicants are encouraged to call the MPA to ensure funding availability. 763-633-4271

An applicant may be suspended from or declared ineligible to participate in the program if the MPA determines that the applicant has submitted false information or otherwise violated program terms and conditions. Within 30 days after MPA suspends or declares an applicant ineligible, the applicant may appeal the action by submitting the appeal in writing to MPA. Actions taken by MPA with respect to the appeal will be final. An applicant who submits false information pertinent to a rebate is subject to criminal and civil penalties including U.S. Mail fraud.
