

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Southeast Cass Water Resource District will receive sealed Bids for the construction of the Sheyenne-Maple Flood Control Project #1-North Pump Station Retrofit, at 1201 West Main Avenue, West Fargo, ND 58078, until 2:00 PM local time on February 7, 2019, at which time the Water Resource District will publicly open and read all Bids timely and properly submitted. The Project consists of replacing pumps and installing a new aeration system for mixing/deicing.

The Water Resource District will receive Bids for a single prime Contract with alternates. Bids must be on a lump sum price basis.

Each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a BIDDER's bond in a sum equal to 5% of the full amount of the BID, executed by the BIDDER as principal and by a surety, conditioned that if the principal's BID is accepted and a CONTRACT is awarded to the principal, the principal, within 10 days after notice of the award, shall execute a CONTRACT in accordance with the terms of the BID and the BID bond, as required by law and the regulations and conditions of the Water Resource District. ALL BID BONDS MUST BE ON THE BID BOND FORM INCLUDED IN THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS. The surety must be licensed to do business in North Dakota, and must be listed as a certified surety in the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Circular 570.

Each bidder must possess a valid North Dakota contractor's license for the full amount of their bid, as required by N.D.C.C. § 43-07-07. Each BIDDER must enclose a copy of their Contractor's License or Certificate of Renewal, issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State, in their bid bond envelope, and each license must be valid and dated at least 10 days prior to the date set for bid opening, as required under N.D.C.C. § 43-07-12.

The Water Resource District will not read or consider any bid that does not fully comply with the requirements above, or the requirements of N.D.C.C. § 48-01.2-05. The Water Resource District will reseal any deficient bid submitted and return it to the bidder immediately.

All BIDs will be made on the basis of cash payment for such WORK. After BID opening the OWNER will return the BID bonds to all BIDDERS except the three lowest responsible BIDDERS. When the Water Resource District awards a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, the Water Resource District will return the remaining BID bonds to the other two BIDDER's. The Water Resource District reserves the right to reject any or all BIDs and to rebid the Project until a satisfactory bid is received. The Water Resource District reserves the right to hold the three low BIDs for a period of 60 days after the date of the BID opening.
