

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the plumbing and heating (mechanical), and electrical portions related to a city project (the erection of a city maintenance shop building) within the City of Casselton will be received by the City Auditor at the City of Casselton City Hall at 702 1st Street North, Casselton, ND 58012, until 2:00 p.m. local time on Monday, November 19, 2018, at which time and place the bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of the plumbing and heating work and electrical work related to a city maintenance building shop within the City of Casselton, at 3575 156th Ave SE, Casselton, ND 58012.

Each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a bidder's bond in a sum equal to 5% of the full amount of the bid executed by the bidder as principal and by a surety, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and a contract is awarded to the principal, the principal, within 10 days after the notice of the award, shall execute a contract in accordance with the terms of the bid and the bid bond, and any conditions of the City of Casselton, as required by law. A countersignature of a bid bond is not required. If the City of Casselton elects to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, and the lowest responsible bidder does not execute a contract within ten days, the bidder's bond will be forfeited to the City of Casselton, and the City of Casselton may award the project to the next lowest responsible bidder.

Each bidder must possess a valid North Dakota contractor's license for the full amount of their bid, as required by N.D.C.C. § 43-07-07. Each bidder **must** enclose a copy of their Contractor's License or Certificate of Renewal, issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State, in their bid bond envelope, and each license must be valid and dated at least 10 days prior to the date set for bid opening, as required under N.D.C.C. § 43-07-12. The contractor must also possess a North Dakota electrical and/or plumbing license as appropriate in order to be eligible to bid on the project.

The City of Casselton will not read or consider any bid that does not fully comply with the requirements above, or the requirements of N.D.C.C. § 48-01.2-05. The City of Casselton will reseal any deficient bid submitted and return it to the bidder immediately.

The City of Casselton reserves the right to hold all bids for a period of 60 days after the date of the bid opening, to reject any or all bids, and to waive any irregularities.
