CODE OF ETHICS

As an associate member you must support the following:

Consulting engineering is an important and learned profession. The members of the profession recognize that their work has a direct and vital impact on the quality of life for all people. Accordingly, the services provided by consulting engineers require honesty, impartiality, fairness and equity and must be dedicated to the protection of public health, safety and welfare. In the practice of their profession, consulting engineers must perform under a standard of professional behavior which requires adherence to the highest principles of ethical conduct on behalf of the public, clients, employees and the profession.

Consulting engineers, in the fulfillment of their professional duties, shall:

- Hold paramount the safety, health and welfare of the public in the performance of their professional duties.
- Perform services only in areas of their competence.
- Issue public statements only in an objective and truthful manner.
- Act in professional matters for each client as faithful agents or trustees.
- Avoid improper solicitation of professional assignments.

These are the fundamental canons of the American Consulting Engineers Council and are subscribed to by all members of the Consulting Engineers Council of Utah.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Associate Membership will be open to individuals or firm members, who have no engineering principals, and provide services that are complementary to the services that our member firms now provide. Associate members can belong to our state organization and need not be members of ACEC. Firms who are eligible to be member firms may not become associate members, and must join in the traditional way. Associate members can have a representative (s) participate on ACEC-Utah committees. They will not be eligible to serve as officers on the board of directors but are eligible to serve as an at large director of the board. Associate members do not have voting privileges.

ACEC Criteria. ACEC Associate Members shall be limited to those sole proprietors, firms, parent firms, branch offices, subsidiaries, and/or organizations that provide professional services of a scientific and technical nature that are complementary to the services provided by member firms.

Each individual or company seeking associate membership with the American Council of Engineering Companies Utah will turn in an application for membership that will be reviewed by the ACEC Utah board of directors.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP DUES

ACEC-Utah Associate membership dues will be \$675.00 per year per firm or company.
